


### A message from Mrs Foston...

Kestrels, Falcons and Hawks- Year 5/6




# Production


# Year 6 Leaver's Assembly

# Attendance - Punctuality Matters

Frequent lateness can negatively affect your child's mental health, learning ability, concentration and friendships. Lates & absences are monitored daily & may result in a letter. This is because children who frequently arrive late are at a significant

disadvantage compared to those who arrive on time, every day. Children who arrive on time are able to settle quickly into class and apply themselves more successfully.

Arriving on time for school is important as late arrivals are disruptive for the class and can be embarrassing for the child who is late. Children can also miss important information during registration including the plan for the day.

#### •Gates open at 8.45am

- •Late arrival is between 9.00am and 9.25am
- Arrival after 9.25am is recorded as Unauthorised

We understand that school mornings can be hectic, but did you know? Being 15 minutes late each day is the same as missing two weeks of school to their learning.






# We Need You...


# Sports Day
