### Attendance

If your child is unable to attend School please let us know by 9am. You can do this via parentmail, telephone (we do have voicemail that is monitored) and by speaking to the office directly. If your child is on prescribed medication and well enough to attend school then they should do so. A consent form can be completed enabling school staff to adminster medicine.



### Lateness – Every Minute Counts

There has been an increase in the number of pupils arriving late for the start of the day. The school day starts at 08.55. Children should be in their classrooms at this time.

Lateness = Lost Learning (Figures below are calculated over a school year)	
5 Minutes late each day	3 days lost!
10 Minutes late each day	6.5 days lost!
15 Minutes late each day	10 days lost!
20 Minutes late each day	13 days lost!
30 Minutes late each day	19 days lost!

If your child attends Breakfast Club they should arrive to school for 8.15am. A member of staff from the Breakfast Club will be at the gate to welcome the children in, and the gate will then close at 8.20am. Unfortunately, if your child/children arrive after the gate has closed, they will have to wait until a member of staff is available to open the gate again. Breakfast Club has become very busy and it is important that the Breakfast Club staff are in the hall making breakfast and supervising the children.

# **Forest School**

As you will see from the diary dates we are heading into a very busy summer term. With this in mind, we have decided to change how we deliver Forest School next half term to avoid clashes and so the children are not overwhelmed. Instead of weekly sessions for specific classes, each class will have a Forest School Day.
