Spring Term 2025

The children settled into school extremely well. The are taking every day in their stride. The children really enjoyed our topics in the Autumn term and particularly enjoyed learning about new stories and getting into the immersive suite.

English – In English we will continue to develop our skills in Read Write Inc Phonics lessons, focusing on blending sounds to read words and using Fred Talk to support writing simple words and phrases using the sounds that we know. We will be exploring the following exciting texts: Superworm, Zog, Supertato, Tyrannosaurus Drip, How to Catch a Dinosaur and The Dinosaur Who Pooped a planet. We will be creating story maps, labelling pictures, ordering scenes from stories and beginning to write with a purpose such as when writing instructions. We will continue our work on forming letters correctly.



Maths - In the Spring Term we will be focusing on developing a deep understanding of numbers beyond 5 up to 10. We will begin to look at comparing these numbers and investigating different ways that we can make 10. We will start to look at mass, length, capacity and time and begin to compare these using everyday and simple mathematical language. We will extend our knowledge of shape to begin to investigate 3D shapes. We will continue to investigate and explore patterns.

Superheroes

We will be learning about superheroes, including everyday heroes such as the police, firefighters and doctors. We will be investigating different occupations and how they help us. This will include visiting the immersive suite to explore different scenarios that happen in daily life. We will learn to use a range of materials creatively to design and make products and to use drawing, painting and sculpture to develop and share ideas, experiences and imagination.



Jurassic Adventure

We will be learning about dinosaurs and comparing these to animals that roam the planet now. We will look at the features of different animals, naming body parts and thinking about the habitats that they live in. We will investigate dinosaurs by going into the immersive suite as well as investigating what it feels like to be in different habitats such as the rainforest, desert and polar regions. We will look at diet and ideas of how to stay healthy.
