The Great Outdoors and Out of Africa



Literacy

As ever, reading is always a key focus, and we are encouraging the children to read for pleasure. To further support this, we will be engaging in some fantastic key texts such as 'Going on a Bear Hunt'. This will encourage children to become familiar with a wider range of books and gain a deeper understanding of our key texts. We will be developing our writing skills, to record simple captions and sentences, that will reflect and further develop our comprehension skills.



Maths

In the Summer Term the children will be building on their existing knowledge of 2D shapes, to develop their knowledge of 3D. Children will also be consolidating their counting skills up to 20 and beyond, children will then be supported to apply this knowledge to their addition and subtraction skills.



The Great Outdoors

After Easter will be being to explore anything and everything in the outside world! This will include exploring various habitats that we can find within the school grounds and finding out about those further afield. We will be looking at animals, minibeasts and plant life as well as continuing to develop our understanding of seasonal change.



Out of Africa

For our learning after May half term, we will be investigating and exploring the animals, geography and cultures in Africa. This will include visits to the immersive suite, reading traditional African stories, trying African food and investigating African animals on our visit to the zoo!
